

Infectious Diseases

SICKNESS/DIARRHOEA	48 hours after vomiting/diarrhoea has stopped
DIPHTHERIA	Until patient declared free from infection by doctor
SCARLET FEVER	Until patient declared free by doctor
MEASLES	7 days from onset of rash if child appears well
GERMAN MEASLES	4 days after rash appears
WHOOPING COUGH	21 days from beginning of the characteristic cough
MUMPS	Until swelling has subsided
CHICKEN POX	6 days from appearance of rash
SMALL POX	Until patient pronounced fit to return by Medical Officer of Health
POLIOMYELITIS	Until pronounced fit to return by Medical Officer of Health
MENINGOCOCCAL INFECTION	Until declared free from infection by Medical Officer Of Health
TYPHOID	Until free from infection by doctor
FOOD POISONING GASTRO ENTERITIS	Until declared fit by doctor
PULMONARY T.B.	Until declared fit by doctor
INFECTIOUS HEPATITIS	Free of infection as soon as child recovered clinically
SCABIES	Until adequately treated
IMPETIGO	Return when infection scabs over if Doctor sees fit
